***“EXPLORING THE SPIRITUALITY OF THE ANGLICAN ROSARY”***

A Lenten Quiet Day scheduled for Saturday, March 13, 2010 at Christ Church Cathedral will provide and introduction to the Anglican Rosary. A tool for *“Holding Your Prayers in Your Hands”*, The Anglican Rosary, with its structure based on the form of the Cross, the Invitatory of the Daily Office, and the Cycle of the Seasons of the Church Year, is a template on which to overlay our prayer, enfolding us on our journey, assisting us to center our thoughts on prayer and listen to God in the silence of our hearts – experiencing the “thin places” where time and timelessness intersect.

We will discuss the Anglican Rosary’s design, and relationship to other Christian forms of prayer ropes and prayer beads, such as used by Roman Catholics and the Orthodox. We will explore the spirituality of the Anglican Rosary, how to make one and use it for those new to it, and a chance to share in various prayer forms for those already experienced in praying the Anglican Rosary. Praying The Labyrinth, Liturgy of The Way of The Cross, and Meditation on The Blessed Sacrament using the Anglican Rosary will also be offered.

Cathedral Parishioner and ESM Alumni Franklin Kline will lead the Quiet Day”. Keynote speaker will be Fr. Rod Wiltse, Priest Associate, Emmanuel Episcopal Church, Webster Grove, Fr. Wiltse, who is instructor of the *“Christian Spirituality”* Module in The Episcopal School for Ministry, will speak on *“Spiritual Disciplines in a Life of Faith”*
